RESOLUTION <u>2001-002</u>

RESOLUTION DEFINING AND DECLARING ECONOMIC REVITALIZATION AREA

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Sellersburg has or has caused to be prepared a map and simplified description of an area proposed to be an Economic Revitalization Area, a copy of which is attached and marked Exhibit "B", and made a part of this resolution, and,

That the Council finds that the area legally described on Exhibit "A" has become undesirable for, or impossible of, normal development and occupancy because of a lack of development, cessation of growth, deterioration of improvements or character of occupancy, age, obsolescence, substandard buildings, or other factors which have impaired the area's values or prevent a normal development or use of the property;

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Town Council finds and declares the area described in Exhibit "B" to be an Economic Revitalization Area, and:

- 1. The time period during which the described area shall be so designated as an Economic Revitalization Area is ten (10) years;
- 2. That the amount of tax abatements allowed within and because of the Economic Revitalization Area shall be for those set forth in I.C. 6-1.1-12.1-3 and I.C. 6-1.1-12.1-4;
- 3. That a copy of this resolution shall be filed with the Clark County Assessor, City-County Building, Jeffersonville, IN.,
- 4. That a copy of this resolution and a copy of the Notice pursuant to I.C. 5-3-1 to the officers of the taxing unit under I.C. 6-1.1-17-5;
- 5. That applicant is authorized to publish notice of this resolution and notice pursuant to I.C. 5-3-1 and I.C. 6-1.1-12.1-2.5.


